

Clareta Walker Scholarship **for** **Interns in Human Development and Family Studies**

The Clareta Walker Scholarship honors a long-term associate of the UI Human Development and Family Studies program. Scholarship funds support two \$500 awards for undergraduate students enrolled in department-sponsored internship experiences. All students planning to complete an HDFS 450 internship during the 2006 spring semester are eligible for one of the awards. Selection preference will be given to students planning an internship involving work with adolescents.

Selection Criteria:

Nature of the planned internship experience (preference given to internships involving work with adolescents)

Professional goals

Scholarship (overall GPA and GPA in HDFS courses)

Minimum Requirements:

Enrollment in HDFS 450 for Spring Semester of current academic year

How to Apply:

1. Complete the Walker Scholarship application form.
2. Attach a statement of how you expect your HDFS 450 internship will help you reach your academic and professional goals.
